Excerpt from BeesCene Article Sept 2007
by Dr. John Boone and Doug McCutcheon

It was 1965 and the Provincial Apiarist John Corner and several beekeeping leaders thought the time seemed right to start a new initiative. This was to be a trust fund to provide an opportunity for the study of Apiculture at a university or college in British Columbia.

Previously the first university affiliated undertaking in BC for the study of honeybees was in 1955. Then, the Beemaster's Course was sponsored jointly by the BC Department of Agriculture and the University of BC Extension Department. Beemaster's certificates had been awarded from time to time since 1933. Instruction and examinations were undertaken through the BC Honey Producers Association (BCHPA) and the Department of Agriculture.

BEESCENE ARTICLE PT I (2007) CONTINUED

At the 1965 Annual General Meeting of the BCHPA, John Corner proposed a trust fund to aid in the establishment of facilities or the study of Apiculture. He donated \$50.00 and suggested the fund bear the names of three dedicated and well respected members of the BCHPA, Harvey Boone, Percy Hodgson and George Wilkinson.

This proposal was approved. After some time and much discussion it was decided the BHW Trust Fund would have the following objectives.

1. To establish an undergraduate course in beekeeping at a recognized university in BC
 2. To provide a bursary or scholarship for a member of a 4-H Honeybee club to attend university, or
 3. For an undergraduate from BC specializing in Apiculture at a Canadian or foreign University.
- There have been refinements since 1965 as situations change

The initial trustees of the fund were Messrs. Boone, Hodgson, Wilkinson and Leo Fuhr, with John Corner ex officio. Harvey Boone was appointed Secretary-Treasurer and when he passed away in 1969 the duties were taken over by George Wilkinson. Ill health forced him to relinquish the job in 1971.
