

BCHPA CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR COURSE

The BCHPA course for certified instructors of Introductory Beekeeping has not been run since before Covid. This coming spring, we hope to offer the course again the day before the semi-AGM. Course participants will be given curriculum requirements, lesson aids and instruction on teaching techniques, followed by a qualifying exam. Enrolment is limited to a maximum of 12 students, and we want a minimum of 8 qualified students to run the course.

1. Must be a BCHPA member in good standing.
2. Presently operating an apiary and have continuously kept honey bees for a minimum of 5 years with preference given to those with more years of experience.
